

PE Premium is allocated to schools based number of pupils on role. It is used to enhance the provision for Physical Education such as:

- New gymnastic mats
- A 9-a-side football pitch
- An all weather table tennis table
- Specialised coaches and teachers such as dance teacher

They are used to enhance children's PE learning and skills by giving them the opportunities to participate in different sports and use the best equipment available.

The money has also been used to buy into a school partnership with James Hornsby Secondary School. With this partnership we are entitled to:

- A qualified coach delivering 3 hours of sport a week
- Access to training on specific sports
- Access to level 3 competitions, leading to level 2 and 1
- CDP training
- Opportunities to gain level two coaching in different sports.

Last year we had great success with our PE. We qualified for TWO level 2 finals which has never been done before. The money allowed us to travel to different venues and partake in more competitions including; basketball, netball and tag rugby.

We also started up a netball team last year and that will continue into this year.
